

Saadi Khochbin, Ph D, DRCE CNRS, is the head of a research team and of a department at the CNRS/INSERM/Grenoble University Research Centre, Institute for Advanced Biosciences. The discovery and the first functional analyses of class II histone-deacetylases (HDACs) in higher eukaryotes exemplify his past contribution. His recent work on the molecular basis of haploid male genome reprogramming is now shedding light on the obscure process of male genome reorganization, and is leading to unexpected applications in cancer biology.
